

# Fireworks

In order to sell fireworks within the city limits of Wellington, you must first obtain a license from the City Clerk's Office. No person, firm or corporation shall store, sell, possess or discharge fireworks at temporary retail stands or other locations, or deliver within the City of Wellington, Kansas, retail fireworks before 12:00 p.m. the 30th day of June and after 12:00 p.m. on the 5th day of July. Retail sales hours shall be from 10:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. on July 1st thru July 4th.

Legal discharge hours shall be from 10:00 a.m. to 11:00 p.m. on July 1st thru July 3rd and 10:00 a.m. to 12:00 o'clock midnight July 4th.

Class C fireworks (common fireworks) are the only fireworks allowed within the city limits of Wellington. Bottle Rockets are strictly prohibited (K.S.A. 31-155).

## Procedure

**In order to qualify for a Fireworks License the applicant must first:**

- Complete an application.
- Provide a fee of \$500 if the fireworks stand is 1,000 square feet or less; or a fee of \$5,000 for a fireworks stand of more than 1,000 square feet.
- Have written permission from the property owners in order to sell, unless the property is that of the seller.
- Provide a Bond or Certificate of Insurance in the amount of \$500,000.00, with coverage and policy numbers.
- Provide a Kansas Sales Tax Number.
- Follow a checklist of guidelines provided by the Wellington Fire Department.
