

2016 Wellington Lake Walleye/Wiper Tournament

The 12th Annual Walleye/Wiper Tournament was held on Saturday ~ May 14, 2016 at the Wellington Lake.

A total of twenty (20) two-person teams competed in the Tournament, despite the cold weather. Twenty-four (24) fish were caught by thirteen (13) different teams. The wiper side of the Tournament was slow with only three (3) fish of legal limit caught. On the walleye side, a total of twenty-one (21) fish were caught that met the legal limit.

Randy Condit caught a wiper that was 24 1/2 inches long and weighed 7.25 lbs for first place. His team won \$200.

Jason Barker caught a wiper that was 18 1/2 inches long and weighed 2.35 lbs for second place. His team won \$100.

Shelly Tracy caught a wiper that was 18 inches long and weighed 2.15 for third place. Her team won \$50.

Jake and Cody Conrad caught four (4) walleye that totalled 8.35 lbs for first place, winning \$500.

Mike Rawley and Robin Evenson caught three (3) walleye that totalled 7.8 lbs for second place, winning \$300.

Terry and Larry Heasty caught three (3) walleye that totalled 6.35 lbs for third place, winning \$200.
