

ORDINANCE NO. 4219

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 3975 ESTABLISHING FEES FOR THE DISPOSAL OF REFUSE, CONSTRUCTION AND DEMOLITION WASTE AND WASTE TIRES AT THE WELLINGTON TRANSFER STATION, WELLINGTON CONSTRUCTION AND DEMOLITION LANDFILL AND THE WASTE TIRE MONOFILL AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 4180

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF WELLINGTON, KANSAS

SECTION I

PROVISION FOR FEES. Provisions for fees for the disposal of different types of waste at the Transfer Station Facility shall be as follows:

- A. Household trash or refuse: \$38.00 per ton
 - Less than one ton:
 - 1,500 to 1,999 lbs. \$36.00
 - 1,000 to 1,499 lbs. \$28.50
 - 500 to 999 lbs. \$19.00
 - 0 to 499 lbs. \$13.50

- B. Construction and Demolition Waste: \$24.00 per ton
 - Less than one ton
 - 1500 to 1,999 lbs. \$22.00
 - 1000 to 1499 lbs. \$16.75
 - 0 to 999 lbs. \$11.50

- C. Waste tires (min. of quartered): \$38.00 per ton

- D. Other:
 - Household appliances (Freon) \$6.00 each
 - Burn barrels \$8.00 each
 - Used oil \$2.00 gallon
 - Antifreeze \$2.00 gallon
 - Batteries \$2.00 each
 - Tires – car \$3.50 each
 - Tires – car on rim \$4.50 each
 - Tires – truck \$11.00 each
 - Tires – truck on rim \$14.00 each
 - Tires – larger \$40.00 each
 - Tires – larger on rim \$45.00 each

- a. Mixed loads of construction debris/household trash will be charged the higher rate of \$38.00 per ton.

- b. No explosives or friable asbestos.
- c. Loads that are not covered or strapped down sufficiently to prevent dropping debris/trash will be charged double the above rate.
- d. Billed accounts must be paid on or before the 20th day after the date of billing rendered, a penalty of ten percent (10%) of the charge shall be added to all current bills for Transfer Station services and shall be collected at the time the bill is finally paid. Failure or refusal of a user to pay the disposal fees is sufficient cause for discontinuing their use of the facility.

SECTION II

Ordinance No. 4180 of the City of Wellington, Kansas is hereby repealed.

SECTION III

This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force on and after January 1, 2018 and after its passage and approval and after its publication in the official City newspaper, as provided by law.
