

# GOLF CARTS

## Golf Cart means:

- A motor vehicle that has not less than three wheels in contact with the ground
- An unladen weight of not more than 1,800 pounds
- Is designed to be operated at not more than 25 miles an hour
- Is designed to carry not more than four persons, including the driver

**Golf carts may be operated upon the public highways, streets, roads and alleys within the corporate limits of the city.**

- (1) No golf cart may be operated upon any public highway, street, road and alley with a posted speed limit in excess of 30 miles per hour.
- (2) No golf cart shall be operated on any interstate highway, federal highway or state highway, provided, however, that the provisions of this subsection shall not prohibit a golf cart from crossing a federal or state highway with a posted speed limit greater than 30 miles per hour.
- (3) No golf cart shall be operated on any public highways, streets, roads and alleys between sunset and sunrise, unless equipped with lights. **NOTE: Kansas State Statute 8-15,108 states: A golf cart shall be operated on any public street or highway ONLY between sunrise and sunset.**
