

SPECIAL PURPOSE VEHICLE Requirements....

Special Purpose Vehicle means golf cart, work site utility vehicle, micro-utility vehicle and all-terrain vehicle either individually or collectively.

Sec. 36-167. Same—Valid driver's license required; penalty; duties and responsibilities.

No person shall operate a golf cart, work site utility vehicle, or a micro-utility truck on any public highway, street, road or alley within the corporate limits of the city unless such person has a valid driver's license. Furthermore, no person shall operate an all-terrain vehicle on any public highway, street, road, or alley within the corporate limits of the city unless such person has a valid driver's license and is 18 years of age or older. Violation of this section is punishable by a fine of not more than \$1,000.00 or by imprisonment for not more than six months or by both such fine and imprisonment.

Sec. 36-168. Same—Insurance required; penalty.

(a) Every owner of a golf cart, work site utility vehicle, micro-utility truck, or all-terrain vehicle shall provide liability coverage in accordance with Section 200 of the 2012 Standard Traffic Ordinance, and amendments thereto, and the Kansas Automobile Injury Reparations Act, K.S.A. 40-3101 et seq., and amendments thereto.

(b) All provisions of Section 200 of the 2012 Standard Traffic Ordinance, and amendments thereto, including penalty provisions, shall be applicable to all owners and operators of golf carts or work site utility vehicles.

Sec. 36-169. Same—Registration and license; fee; application; inspection; penalty.

Before operating any golf cart, work site utility vehicle, micro-utility truck, or all-terrain vehicle on any public highway, street, road or alley within the corporate limits of the city and each calendar year thereafter, the vehicle shall be registered with the city and a license shall be obtained and placed on the vehicle. The license fee shall be \$25.00 per calendar year, payable in advance. The full amount of the license fee shall be required regardless of the time of year that the application is made.
