- Mixed loads of construction debris/household trash will be charged the higher rate of \$37.00 per ton.
- No explosives or asbestos.
- Loads that are not covered or strapped down sufficiently to prevent dropping debris/trash will be charged double the above rate.
- Billed accounts must be paid on or before the 20th day after the date of billing rendered, a penalty of ten percent (10%) of the charge shall be added to all current bills for Transfer Station services and shall be collected at the time the bill is finally paid. Failure or refusal of a user to pay the disposal fees is sufficient cause for discontinuing their use of the facility.
