

# WORKSITE UTILITY VEHICLES

## **Work site utility vehicle means:**

- Any motor vehicle which is not less than 48 inches in width
- Has an overall length, including the bumper, of not more than 135 inches
- Has an unladen weight, including fuel and fluids, of more than 800 pounds
- Equipped with four or ore low pressure tires
- Equipped with a steering wheel and bench or bucket type seating allowing at least two people to sit side-by-side
- May be equipped with a bed or cargo box for hauling materials

## **Work site utility vehicle does not include a micro utility vehicle**

**Work-site utility vehicles may be operated upon the public highways, streets, roads and alleys within the corporate limits of the city, except as follows:**

- (1) No work-site utility vehicle may be operated on any public highway, street, road and alley with a posted speed limit in excess of 30 miles per hour.
- (2) No work-site utility vehicle may be operated on any public highway, street, road and alley between sunset and sunrise unless such vehicle is equipped with lights as required for motor vehicles under K.S.A. ch. 8, art. 17, and amendments thereto.
