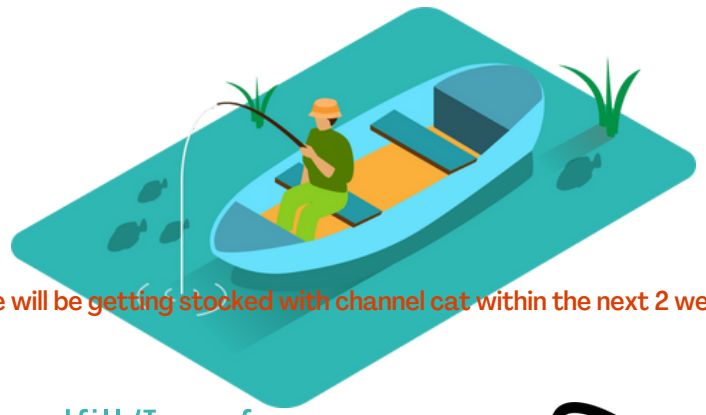

## BUILDING & CODES

REMINDER: THERE IS NO CHARGE FOR DISPOSAL OF YARD WASTE AT THE COMPOST SITE

Fall is finally here and The City of Wellington Building & Codes Department would like to remind our citizens about the proper disposal of yard clippings.

Section 28-20 - "Littering shall include, but is not necessarily limited to, rubbish, garbage, and trash, including tree limbs, yard clippings, paper, metal, plastic, glass, eggs, tomatoes, and similar items."

**If you are unable to haul your yard waste (leaves & lawn clippings) to the Compost Site, you may purchase yard waste tags from the Utility Office located at City Hall (317 S. Washington).**



Yard Waste Only-NO TRASH  
Maximum bag size: 33 gallons  
Maximum bag weight: 40 pounds  
\$1.00/each or six (6) for \$5.00.  
One tag is required per bag.

The Sanitation crew will collect tagged bags with weekly trash service.
