Citizens can receive their utility bills same day by requesting the statement be sent via email rather than through the mail. We also offer automatic or ACH monthly payments. This option is free, whereas our online vendor PSN charges customers to pay online. You also don't have the worry about your payment arriving on time. We will simply email you a form to fill out, then you drop it back off along with your bank information
