Insurance Requirement \$300,000/\$300,000
Fee: \$150.00 (2-year license cycle)

_____ Class C Residential: One & two family residences, accessory buildings thereto
Minimum of three years experience
Insurance Requirement \$300,000/\$300,000
Fee: \$100.00 (2-year license cycle)

_____ Class D Specialty: Remodel, repair and maintenance of dwelling units(Roofing/Siding)
Minimum of two years experience
Insurance Requirements \$300,000/\$300,000
Fee: \$100.00 (2-year license cycle)
